Plant material within Building Envelope will be approved on a lot by lot basis. Most cultivar will be acceptable within the appropriate climate zone.

Vegetable Garden

Acceptable if located 3m or more from the property lines. Fences will be permitted around vegetable gardens to a maximum of 1.2m in height and must be developer approved fences i.e. black chain link.
